1) Qualification: International students at NTNU and Mandarin Training Center.

2) Date & Time:

Preliminary (Round): 18:30-21:30, May 4, 2017 (Thur.), General Building Room 301 (Library Campus)

Final (Round): 18:30-21:30, May 11, 2017 (Thur.), Auditorium (Main Campus)

3) Category:

Individual (For International students at NTNU or Mandarin Training Center only)

Group (2~4 people per team; including at least one international student of NTNU or MTC, other members can be students or staffs of NTU system.)

NTNU Staff Individual or Group

* International students are welcome to team up with local students!

4) Prizes:

1st place: certificate & NT\$ 4,000

Best Popularity Award: certificate & NT\$ 500

2nd place: certificate & NT\$ 2,000

Best Performance Award: certificate & NT\$ 500

(1) There will be preliminary and final

(2) Every participant has to sing Chinese song only

(3) Six people in each category will move on to the final

Information of Participation

1) Chinese song only, except for the bonus singing. Participant can only sing 90 seconds song in preliminary, and have other 30 seconds bonus of singing without instrument. As for final, participant can sing one whole song that is not more than 8 minutes.

2) Every participant should enroll before 30 minutes of the contest; student ID is required.

3) Song of preliminary and final can be the same.

4) Please email your 90 seconds instrumental music (mp3.) to 2017singingcontest@gmail.com before 4/28.

5) Remember to inform us your name and whether you want to register as a team or as individual in the email. We will not accept late application.

6) Please test your music in advance. Original performers' voice cannot appear in your music. OIA is not

responsible for examining your music. We'll not responsible for any point deduction for an unqualified music you provide.
